Section A, Artistic Crafts: "Let's Celebrate!"

Eligible for Botanical Arts Artistic Crafts Award

Class 1 "Happy 100th Birthday!" A 5" x 7" one-sided invitation to a party, mounted on an 8" x 10" piece of matting board, provided by exhibitor, and displayed on clear acrylic easel provided by committee. No underlay allowed. Staged on an off-white mantel shelf 54.5" from the floor and 10" deep, in front of an off-white wall. Designer's choice of dried plant material and other components. Wording and lettering allowed. Four (4) exhibits.

Class 2 "A Shoe Fit for a Party" A shoe, provided by exhibitor. The inside of the shoe and the bottom sole must be free of anything that would interfere with the actual wearing of the shoe, but all other parts of the shoe must be covered in plant material and optional components. Staged on an 18" wide x 30" high table, provided by committee. Viewable from all sides. Underlay required, not to exceed 15" square. Designer's choice of fresh and/or dried plant material and other components. Fresh plant material may not be treated. Dried plant material may be treated. Paint or polish with shimmer, pearlized, metallic and sparkle is permitted, but no loose glitter. Four (4) exhibits.

Class 3 "Party Bling" AA necklace using a structure created by exhibitor. Mechanics must not be visible. Necklace must be functional and ready to wear with clasp made of plant material. Staged on a black velvet necklace display stand provided by committee, 12" h x 8" w, and placed on a table 30" from the floor, covered in off-white cloth, in front of off-white walls and windows. Designer's choice of fresh and/or dried plant material. Fresh plant material may not be treated.
