Favorite Nurseries

la serra gardens, Totowa

There's no place more magical to wander than la serra. Give yourself time to browse the incredible selection of indoor and outdoor plants, including the most beautiful, organic veggies and herbs grown by Peace Tree Farm. La serra also offers stunning containers, trellises and accents that truly make your garden special. You'll find lovely curated gifts for any occasion in the shop. And there's even a cafe with specialty drinks and homemade baked goods. (The coffee is perfection and the pignoli cookie is divine.)

Farms View Roadstand, Wayne

Located in Wayne, this delightful roadstand is part indoor farmer's market, part nursery. You can take care of your weekly food shopping (much of the produce is grown right there on the farm!) and shop beautiful seasonal flowers and veggie plants in the nursery area outside. There are even barnyard animals if you have little ones.

Pleasantdale Nursery, Verona

This reliable nursery is a solid standby and usually has whatever I need. From veggies and herbs to beautiful seasonal plants, shrubs and flowers, they have a solid selection, very fair pricing and the owner is always welcoming and helpful.

Metropolitan Plant Exchange, Caldwell

This comprehensive garden center moved in 2025 from its longtime spot in West Orange to Caldwell. Metropolitan carries it all, from a diverse selection of veggies, flowers and shrubs, to quality bagged soils, amendments and seeds.

Country Mile Gardens, Morristown
